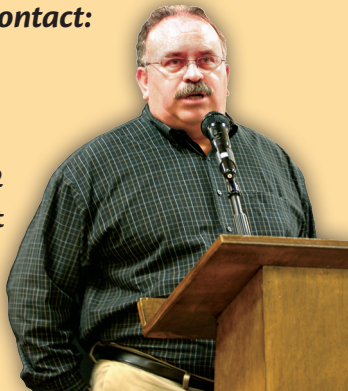
Most topics are ideal for a 20 minute presentation, though most may also be extended with more detail to fit a specific request.

Outages

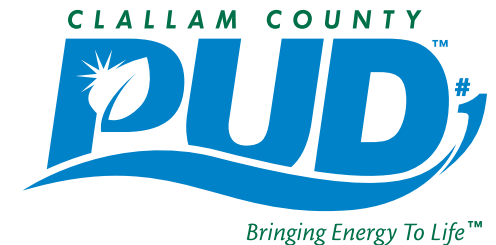
On the Washington Peninsula we all know outages can and do occur. What should you do to prepare and what does the PUD do in the case of an outage?
